

## Cold Milk Checklist

## **Milk Storage**

	Check milk temp and taste at delivery every time and store immediately.  • Milk temperature should be between 35°F and 40°F. Strive for 35°F!
	Store milk in the coldest part of the cooler.  In the back of walk-ins  At the lowest level of a milk cooler
	Place milk far away from food with a strong odor.
	Don't overload the cooler. Make sure air can flow under, above, and around the milk.
	Wipe up spills immediately to prevent slipping and development of off odors.
Storage Equipment Maintenance	
	Clean cooler regularly including drains, vents, and gaskets to help it run efficiently.
	Replace worn gaskets to keep in the cold air.
	Check cooler temperatures daily and keep below 40°F.
<b>During Transportation &amp; Service</b>	
	Keep milk refrigerated, on ice, or in insulated totes or coolers
	Close the cooler lid/doors between meal wayes
