About 80% of a dairy cow's diet is inedible to humans.




Cows have a keen sense of smell - they can smell things up to 6 miles away!





To digest food, cows chew their cud 50 times per minute, 10 hours a day!




















More than 95% of New England's 1,000+ dairy farms are family owned and operated.
